



World Disability Union Certificate of Initiatives

> Introduction of the Certificate:

The Initiative Certificate is granted by the World Disability Union from the headquarters, in recognition of thanks and appreciation to everyone who has provided and continues to provide services that facilitate the daily lives of people with disabilities in all fields (sports - recreational - educational, etc...) according to the following criteria:

- The initiative must be sustainable and benefit the largest number of people with disabilities.
- The initiative must be applicable, and it has actually started.

Certificate Objectives:

- Stimulating the spirit of competition in society to provide initiatives that benefit people with disabilities.
- Spreading awareness in the community about the issues of people with disabilities.
- Finding solutions to some of the difficulties facing people with disabilities.
- Honoring people who are proactive and interested in providing services to people with disabilities.

> First: How to apply for a certificate:

- The headquarters of the World Disability Union has the right to choose public figures who presented initiatives for people with disabilities, and those initiatives where implemented in the community and were beneficial to the largest number of people with disabilities.
- The owner of the initiative must submit the following documents to obtain the certificate:
- 1) Curriculum Vitae.
- 2) An explanation of the initiative or initiatives that he presented.
- 3) Evidence of the implementation of the initiative (photos, video, a letter from the institution where the initiative was implemented ...).
- 4) Any other documents that the owner of the initiative wishes to submit.
- Any institution has the right to nominate the person it considers the qualities and conditions of the initiative, provided that the institution submits the following documents:
- 1) A copy of the decision to publicize the institution or the license of the institution.
- 2) Curriculum Vitae for the owner of the initiative.
- 3) An explanation of the initiative or initiatives that he presented.
- 4) Evidence of the implementation of the initiative (photos, video, a letter from the institution where the initiative was implemented,).

- Second: The World Disability Union has the right to accept or reject any nomination (in accordance with the criteria of the World Disability Union).
- ➤ <u>Third:</u> Issuing the certificate of the World Disability Union "Initiatives" and announcing it on the Union's website and sending the certificate to the honored person according to the procedures followed in the union.
- Fourth: The World Disability Union has the right to cancel the certificate, if it found that the information previously provided is incorrect.
